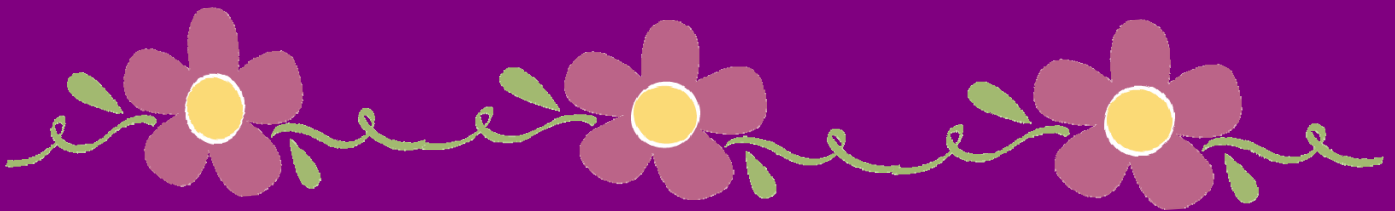
For Colored Girls Who Have Considered Suicide When The Rainbow is Enuf

This 1975 stage play, For Colored Girls Who Have Considered Suicide When the Rainbow is Enuf, was first performed in Berkeley, California, produced both off and on Broadway and adapted as a TV movie. For Colored Girls is a series of poems that deal with love, abandonment, rape, domestic violence and courage through nameless women referred to by their color: "Lady in Yellow", "Lady in Purple", etc.
