The History of the Mott College Public Safety Department: PA 614

The MCC Department of Public Safety was established on November 22, 1997. In 1998, upon passage of legislation entitled PA 614, Mott Community College became the first community college in the State of Michigan to operate an independent full-service law enforcement agency.

The intent of PA 614 was to extend to Michigan community colleges the statutory authority to establish police departments under their own jurisdiction. One crucial requirement of PA 614 is that an Advisory/Oversight Committee was created. The MCC Public Safety Committee was formed during .

The 1998-99 academic year. This committee meets monthly to review departmental developments. Committee members also share information to include constituent concerns.
