**DATE OF ISSUANCE: April 19, 2011**

**Department Complaint Number: 11000192**

**REPORTED OFFENSE: ATTEMPT ARMED ROBBERY**– At 11:30 am on Tuesday, 04-19-11, the victim, who is known to the suspect, was approached by the suspect in the Curtice Mott Building, area of room 1135. Suspect demanded money owed to him by victim. When victim refused, suspect reached into his right pocket and indicated to victim that he had a gun. Suspect stated to victim that he would shoot him. Suspect then attempted to strike victim in the head with his fist, but missed knocking victim's hat off. Suspect then fled the scene on foot, running north toward the G Parking Ramp. Suspect is not currently a student at Mott Community College. Victim states the suspect is known to carry a handgun on his person.

**SUSPECT(S):** Demetrius Ernest, black/male, 20 years of age, 5'10", 190 lbs., medium complexion, wearing a red and blue jacket, blue jeans

**SAFETY TIPS:** If you see the suspect do not approach him, report the sighting as soon as possible to the Department of Public Safety at 810-762-0222.

**SUSPECT(S):** black male, 6' tall, skinny build, very dark skinned complexion, black shoulder length hair, all black clothing, wearing a hoody

**REPORTED OFFENSE: ARMED ROBBERY**– On Monday, 08-09-10, at approximately 3:38pm, victim had parked his vehicle in H Parking Ramp, on the third level, and had started walking. The two suspects walked past victim, then turned and struck victim in the head with a cane, carried by the one suspect. Suspects took victims wallet, which was later found in the drive leading up to the next level of the parking ramp, minus victims money.

**SUSPECT(S):** Described as two black, males, mid 20's, medium build, wearing long white T-shirts, no facial hair on either suspect, one suspect carrying a brown cane, which was used to strike the victim.

**SAFETY TIPS:** Even though patrols on the entire campus have increased, walk in groups whenever possible and be aware of your surroundings. If necessary call Public Safety for an escort to your vehicle.

**REPORTED OFFENSE: ATTEMPTED SEXUAL ASSAULT**– On today's date, it was reported that an attempted sexual assault occurred on Thursday, April 15, 2010 at approximately 4:00 p.m. in the Mott Community College Ramp G, lower level. The victim stated that the suspect approached her from behind, grabbed her around her torso and pulled her into the stairwell where he attempted to sexually assault her. **SUSPECT(S):** Male, white, approximately 6 feet tall, short carrot-red hair combed forward in the front, medium build, 20 to 30 years of age.

**SUSPECT(S):** Suspect is described as a black male, light skinned, approximately 5'10" tall, had medium length braided hair, wearing a tan Carhartt coat and baggy pants.

**SAFETY TIPS:** Do Not Carry Large Sums of Money on Campus! When using the bathroom go in pairs or use the stall
