

Joe Perisa History Achievement Award

A student award for outstanding achievement in History to be given each year during the Honors and Awards Ceremony to a deserving history student at Mott.

You are eligible to apply for the award when you have completed at least two history courses at Mott Community College.

Award Criteria:

1. A 3.5 minimum g.p.a. in history
2. At least a 3.0 over-all g.p.a.
3. The completion of at least two papers in the field of history (each paper at least 500 words in length and at least a 3.0 grade on the paper.)

Announcement of the award recipients will be made in May at the Honors and Awards Ceremony.

Directions for making application:

1. Obtain award application form from any history instructor at Mott.
2. Complete the award application per form instructions
*Note – application may be made by a student desiring to be considered for the award or by any individual aware of a student with outstanding achievement in History.
3. Return the completed application form in a sealed business size envelope to the History Discipline Representative no later than _____.
4. The full-time history instructors will meet within a week after the application deadline. Collectively, they will evaluate the applications and select the recipient.
