SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be a student and be in good standing at Mott Community College.
2. Applicants must possess a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0, and should have at least completed 45 credits at the time of awarding.
3. Applicants must have demonstrated ongoing activity with Mott Community College student organizations and civic initiatives. This must be included in the student statement attached to the Scholarship Application Data Sheet.
4. Semester award of \$1,000 must be applied towards tuition, books tools and/or supplies.
