AHLT – 101 Exploring Health Professions

Online Resources: Use these databases to locate articles from magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books and entire ebooks.

- Choose “Online Resources” Note: when accessing from off campus, users will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number, above the barcode on the front of their Mott ID card.

CINAHL & CINAHL Plus (with full text) - Indexes articles from several hundred nursing, allied health and consumer health sources. You can limit your search to “full text” when you click on the “Advanced Search” tab.

Health Reference Center Academic (found within Thomson Gale

PowerSearch) - This multi-source database provides access to full-text nursing, medical and allied health journals, consumer health magazines, topical overviews and reference books.

Library Catalog: The catalog locates books in the Mott College Library and other libraries.

- Choose “Library Catalog” Note: books in the Mott College Library will have the Mott apple tree icon next to the title. You can request books from Baker or Kettering using the “Request Item” link.

MeLCat: Use MeLCat to locate books in the collections of over 100 Michigan libraries and have the books sent to the Mott College Library.

- Choose “Michigan eLibrary/mel.org” icon.
- Choose “MeLCat”.
