Online Resources: The databases are used to locate articles from magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books and entire ebooks.

- Choose "Online Resources" Note: when accessing from off campus, users will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number, above the barcode on the front of their Mott ID card.

JSTOR: Full-text scholarly journals - The JSTOR database consists of complete back files of core scholarly journals in all disciplines which have been digitized, starting with the very first issues. Although there are no children's literature-specific journals archived in JSTOR, you will find articles on the topic in many of the education and literature journals that are.

Wilson Select Plus (found within OCLC First Search) – This database is an excellent source for full-text articles in the fields of humanities, social science and education.

Academic OneFile and Educators Reference Complete (found within Thomson Gale PowerSearch) - These databases contain peer-reviewed, full-text articles from academic journals.

Library Catalog: Use the catalog to locate books in the Mott College Library and other libraries.

- Choose "Library Catalog" Note: books in the Mott College Library will have the Mott apple tree icon next to the title.
- You can limit your search to children's literature books by hi-lighting "MCC Children's Literature" in the "Limits" box.
- You can request books from Baker or Kettering using the "Request Item" link.

MeLCat: MeLCat locates books in the collections of over 100 Michigan libraries and allows users to have the books sent to the Mott College Library.

- Choose "Michigan eLibrary/mel.org" icon.
- Choose "MeLCat".

Something about the Author PN 451 .S6 (Children's literature reference)

An easy-to-use source for students, and other researchers, this volume provides illustrated biographical profiles of children's authors and artists, ranging from established award winners to authors and illustrators who are just beginning their careers.

Children's Literature Review PN 1009.A1 C5139 (Children's literature reference)

This important series, offers excerpts from reviews, criticism and commentary on books for Children and Young people.

Illustrator's of Children's Books 1744 to 1945 NC 965 .M64 (Children's literature reference)

This book provides the history and development of illustrated books plus biographies and bibliographies of illustrators and their works.
