Online Resources: The databases are used to locate articles from magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books and entire ebooks.

- Choose “Online Resources” Note: when accessing from off campus, users will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number, above the barcode on the front of their Mott ID card.

JSTOR: Full Text Scholarly Journals - JSTOR's search engine allows users to browse and search individual journals, or perform cross-disciplinary searches of multiple journals in multiple disciplines.

InfoTrac War and Terrorism Collection (found within Thomson Gale PowerSearch) – This collection contains over 100 subject appropriate full-text journals

Military and Intelligence Database (found within Thomson Gale PowerSearch) – This database contains over 400 journals covering all aspects of military and intelligence services.

Wilson Select Plus (found within OCLC FirstSearch) – The database contains full full-text articles from academic journals and trade publications

Library Catalog: Locate books in the Mott College Library and other libraries with the catalog.

- Choose “Library Catalog” Note: books in the Mott College Library will have the Mott apple tree icon next to the title. You can request books from Baker or Kettering using the “Request Item” link.

MeLCat: MeLCat locates books in the collections of over 100 Michigan libraries and lets users have the books sent to the Mott College Library.

- Choose “Michigan eLibrary/mel.org” icon.
- Choose “MeLCat”.
