Online Resources: Use these databases to locate articles from magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books and entire ebooks.

- Choose “Online Resources” Note: when accessing from off campus, users will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number, above the barcode on the front of their Mott ID card.

JSTOR: Full Text Scholarly Journals - JSTOR's search engine allows users to browse and search individual journals, or perform cross-disciplinary searches of multiple journals in multiple disciplines. There are many journals from the field of film studies available in full-text on JSTOR.

Academic OneFile (found within Thomson Gale PowerSearch) - Content includes more than 11,000 periodical titles in all with nearly 30 years of coverage. Included are the subjects of digital production, film studies and the entertainment industry.

Wilson Select Plus (found within OCLC FirstSearch) – The database contains full full-text articles from academic journals and trade publications

Westlaw Campus Research – this database contains hundreds of newspapers, newswires, magazines, and broadcast transcripts. Much of the information can't easily be found on the Internet or any other readily available sources.

Library Catalog: The catalog locates books in the Mott College Library and other libraries.

- Choose “Library Catalog” Note: books in the Mott College Library will have the Mott apple tree icon next to the title. You can request books from Baker or Kettering using the “Request Item” link.

MeLCat: MeLCat allows users to locate books in the collections of over 100 Michigan libraries and have the books sent to the Mott College Library.

- Choose “Michigan eLibrary/mel.org” icon
- Choose “MeLCat”.
