### **Physical Therapy Assistant**

**Online Resources:** Use these databases to locate articles from magazines, journals, newspapers, reference books and entire ebooks.

- Choose “Online Resources” Note: when accessing from off campus, users will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number, above the barcode on the front of their Mott ID card.

***CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature)*** - Indexes articles from several hundred nursing, allied health and consumer health sources. You can limit your search to “full text” when you click the “Full Text” box.

***Nursing and Allied Health Collection (found within Thomson Gale Power Search)*** - This multi-source database provides access to full-text nursing, medical and allied health journals, consumer health magazines, topical overviews and reference books.

***MEDLINE (found within OCLC First Search)*** - MEDLINE provides indexing and abstracting to over 10,000 nursing and allied health journals. You can limit your search to journals that can be found in the Mott College Library.

***Gale Virtual Reference Library*** - Gale Virtual Reference Library is a database of encyclopedias, almanacs, and specialized reference sources.

**Library Catalog:** The catalog locates books in the Southern Lakes OTA/PTA Resource Center and other libraries.

- Choose “Library Catalog” Note: books in the Mott College Library will have the Mott apple tree icon next to the title. You can request books from Baker or Kettering using the “Request Item” link.

**MeLCat:** MeLCat allows users to locate books in the collections of over 100 Michigan libraries and have the books sent to the Mott College Library.

- Choose “Michigan eLibrary/mel.org” icon.
- Choose “MeLCat”.
