Mott Community College will award articulated credit to students for the secondary course(s) according to the conditions/requirements listed below. This credit applies only to MCC degrees and certificates (may not transfer to other institutions). This agreement is valid until date of discard below. Tuition will not be charged. No grades will be recorded for articulated courses.

Conditions and Requirements:

All students requesting MCC credit must have instructor recommendation and must meet the following conditions:

1. Students must enroll at MCC and apply for articulated credit within two years of high school graduation.
2. Students must enroll in a related program of study (Electronics & Electrical Technology) at MCC for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
3. Students in the **Construction Trades II or Residential Electrical, Plumbing & HVAC** program must successfully complete (3.0 GPA) ELEC 133 (Electrical Circuits) to receive and post credit for ELEC 131 Residential Wiring (3 credits) on the student's transcript. **Consultation with the program coordinator prior to registration is recommended.**
4. An Articulation Application form with high school instructor signature indicating specific college courses they recommend for college credit will be sent to MCC with the student application for admission and other attachments as indicated.
5. Students shall meet and maintain entrance requirements of MCC and the intended program of study.
6. Students must earn a minimum of 30 college credits at Mott to qualify for an Associate degree and a minimum of 20 college credits for a Certificate. No more than 50 percent of credits required in specialized course work, unique to a program, can be transferred and applied toward graduation from MCC.




