PSYC 281 – General Psychology

Application Periods: January 1-15 for the following Fall Admission and September 1-15 for the following Winter Admission. Apply to the Education program at the University of Michigan-Flint

- Completion of MATH 210, ENGL 101 & 102, HIST 154 or 155 with a minimum grade of C
- Completion of PSYC 281 & SCI. 101 with a minimum grade of C
- Overall GPA 2.70 or better
- Minors GPA 2.70 or better
