- Students completing the B.A. degree may take three semesters of a foreign language. Students completing the B.S. degree may take MATH 150.
- This guide fulfills the Michigan Transfer agreement (MTA). Science electives must be selected from different disciplines. Humanities electives must be selected from different disciplines. Please check with your community college advisor for additional associate degree requirements. **GVSU will still honor the MACRAO agreement.**
- It is strongly recommended that students transfer after one year.
- Students must take both MATH 210 and MATH 220 to receive specific credit that fulfill a requirement in this program at Grand Valley.
