

TECHNOLOGY CLUB CONSTITUTION

Mott Community College

Preamble:

We, the members of the Technology Club, in order to form an organization beneficial to ourselves, and the college, do hereby ordain and establish this constitution for the Technology Club.

Article I – Name

Section 1 – This club shall be known as the Technology Club.

Article II – Purpose

Section 1 – To promote an increased understanding of technology used in today’s demanding workforce.

Section 2 – To provide means of social interaction and broad exposure to the field of technology for current MCC students.

Article III – Membership

Section 1 – This club’s membership shall be open to any Mott Community College student, regardless of age, gender, race, or religion; enrolled in any MCC course. Membership is guaranteed for a one year period unless a member withdraws their membership in writing with an Advisor.

Section 2 – Memberships must be renewed every fall Semester

Section 3 – Only club members are allowed to travel with the club. Of these members, only those that have completed the Emergency Contact information and the Sexual Harassment Training online, at least three weeks prior to the travel date will be allowed to travel.

Article IV – Officers and Duties

Section 1 – The Technology Club shall have as Officers a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Student Representative.

Section 2 – The duties of the Officers are as follows:

President – Presides at all meetings, enforces order at all meetings, calls special meetings with consent of the members, and makes executive decisions with the club Advisor.

Vice President – Presides at meetings in the absence of the President, presides over all committees, and makes executive decisions with the club Advisor in the absence of the President.

Secretary – Handles all correspondence, keeps accurate minutes of all meetings.

Treasurer – Handles all finances, keeps accurate records of all accounts.

Student Representative – Attend meetings; promote recruiting; research articles and activities; communicate programs, events, and upcoming information to students.

Article V – Elections

Section 1 – Election meeting is presided over by the Advisor(s) and held during the first meeting of the year.

Section 2 – Election of officers is held by secret ballot from those nominated for open positions.

Section 2 – A special election may be called by the President with a one week advance notice and consent of the members.

Article VI – Meetings

Section 1 – Regular meetings shall be scheduled with the consent of the voting members.

Section 2 – There shall be at least one regular meeting held every calendar month of the academic year.

Article VII – Committees

Section 1 – All committees shall be appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the other Officers.

Section 2 – The following standard committees shall be provided and maintained during the entire academic year:

Fund Raiser Committee: Whose duties shall include organization and execution of fund raising activities.

Article VIII – Recall

Section 1 – The members reserve for themselves the right to recall any of the officers with a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the entire voting membership. The recall must be conducted by secret ballot.

Section 2 – Election of replacement officer(s) is also completed by secret ballot of those nominated.

Additions and deletions to this constitution may be made with the consent of the Current & Active Members.
