

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS

SAP will be calculated once per academic year to determine eligibility for the next academic year. A student's entire academic record is included in this calculation. Fresh Start is not observed for Federal Financial Aid purposes.

Satisfactory Progress is maintained when you complete 67% of your coursework successfully, maintain a cumulative gpa of 2.0 or better and do not exceed the maximum timeframe of 80 attempted credits. Violations of the SAP standards will result in the termination of your financial aid.

Once the 80 credit hour maximum has been reached for TIP, you are no longer eligible for the TIP program (no exceptions).

For continued TIP funding, all approved appeals and/or default clearings must be submitted within TIP's academic year (Sep 1-Aug 31) in order to receive funding for that year.

TUITION INCENTIVE PROGRAM "TIP" BASIC INFORMATION

Students on TIP must register for **at least 6 credit hours for Fall and Winter** semesters and **at least 3 credit hours for Spring and Summer** Semesters. Students are responsible to verify that their TIP benefits are being applied.

Provided that the TIP student is enrolled part-time or more:

TIP will cover:

Credit hours (max. 24 per year)
Enrollment Fee
Technology Fees for Credit hours

TIP will not cover

Contact/Billable Hours that **exceed** Credit hours
Course/Class Fees
Fees that exceed \$250 a semester

You must start using your TIP funding within 4 years of high school graduation/GED completion. Once you have started using TIP, you have 10 years from high school graduation /GED completion to fully use the 80 credit hours available.
