The National Repository of Online Courses (NROC) is a project of the Monterey Institute for Technology and Education, a not-for-profit organization. The primary goal of NROC is to assemble a library of high-quality general education content for high school and college gathered from educational institutions across the US. Learn how current NROC members are using NROC content - a repository of 34 complete course foundations and over 2500 unique learning objects - to support institutional initiatives, from distance learning and blended learning to credit recovery and traditional classrooms. Lessons are media rich, with video, audio, text, graphics, animations, simulations all blended together to create a rich learning experience.
