ART.-248 Graphic Design Internship

Proposed revised credit and contact hours from 3/3 to 1-3/1-3 to allow for variable hours based on the number of internship hours. This complies with Perkins reporting and aligns the Graphic Design Internship with Photography and Media Arts programs.

RTAD-222 Respiratory Neonatal/Pediatric Care

Proposed increase in credit hours and contact hours from 1.25/1.75 to 2/3. Addresses the need of more comprehensive education in this specialty area of respiratory care and better student preparation for entering the neonatal and pediatric intensive care settings. Increased lab time for clinical simulations. The course description was also updated.

RTAD-225 Respiratory Diagnostics/Sub Acute Care

Proposed name change from Respiratory Diagnostics/Sub Acute Care to Diagnostics/Post-Acute Care.

THTR-110 Introduction to Theatre

Proposed course title and description change from Introduction to Theatre to Theatre Appreciation with the following description: an introduction to the elements and structure of live theatre. Topics include the historical development, terminology, and production aspects of live theatre; play structure and storytelling; and the role of theatre in society and as a reflection of its culture. Students are required to attend a performance outside of class.
