## Action/Effective Date

### **Developmental Ed Steering Committee Student Placement Test Policy Change**

Received for Information

Proposed that MCC establish a new policy of placing specific expiration date for student's placement test (or ACT/SAT) scores.

Recommended that Julie Steffey and members of the Developmental Steering Committee and Troy Boquette and his representatives develop a procedure that would address the concerns but eliminate the need for a policy change. This will be presented at the Academic Affairs meeting in May 2016.

### **Five-Year Program Completion Requirement Recommendation from Developmental Ed Steering Committee**

Approved

Proposed that MCC establish a new policy requiring students to complete their program of study within five years of the date of the student's original catalog (with an appeal option).

Fall 2016

Recommended language change: "Students who are not enrolled continuously (no credits attempted for one academic year) or who change programs will be required to follow the most current catalog at the time of returning or program change".

The catalog expiration portion of the original proposed policy will be discussed in more detail at the Division meetings in August 2016.
