



Green Construction Trades Certificate Program (GCON5)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

An accelerated program designed to provide the basic skills for individuals who wish to enter the Green Construction industry with a significant level of academic achievement. Courses include: Construction Fundamentals, Blueprint Reading, Lead Asbestos, and Mold, Deconstruction, Weatherization/Retrofitting, Trade Math and Core Abilities/Team Building. Those who successfully complete the Carpentry and the Electrical component, receive seven articulated credits by taking the next two classes in those areas. There are two other options of this program to choose from; the six week program concentrates on demolition and deconstruction while the four week program concentrates on Weatherization. This program is 600 Clock hours.

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

NOCR-GCON01

The Green Construction (GCON) program is a program that will be held in the Building and Construction Lab. The GCON program is a modification of building construction with a focus on energy conservation and energy efficiency. It includes weatherization, retrofitting and deconstruction.
