PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Social Work Technician Associate (SWT) program prepares graduates for employment in social service fields by providing an understanding of social work methods, skills, philosophy, and human behavior. The student learns how to do initial intakes, assessments, and crisis intervention skills. They also participate in on-the-job training by doing practicums at local social service agencies. The SWT program prepares graduates to qualify for licensure as a Social Service Technician under the Michigan Bureau of Health Professions.
