FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Online

www.fafsa.ed.gov Mott's School Code – **002261**

Students, parents, and borrowers are **required** to use an *FSA ID*, made up of a username and password, to access certain U.S. Department of Education websites. Your FSA ID is used to confirm your identity when accessing your financial aid information and electronically signing your *federal student aid* documents.

Student: To accept your loan offer complete the **Entrance Counseling** (undergraduate) & **Master Promissory**.

Parents: To apply for a Direct PLUS Loan the parent would need to log into studentloans.gov with their FSA ID. They must complete a Direct PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note (Direct PLUS Loan MPN), which explains all of the terms and conditions of Direct PLUS Loans and constitutes your legally binding agreement to repay all Direct PLUS Loans that you receive under the Direct PLUS Loan MPN. You will have an opportunity to complete the Direct PLUS Loan MPN after you complete the Direct PLUS Loan Request.
