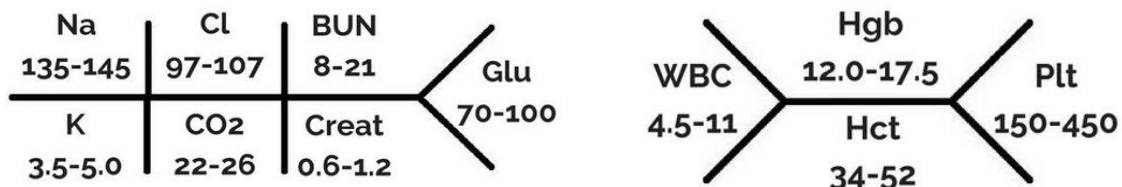
5. List the signs/symptoms associated with the priority medical condition. Highlight or star (*) the signs/symptoms your client experienced.

8. What are common laboratory and/or diagnostic tests ordered for a client with the priority medical condition? Include your client's results, if available.

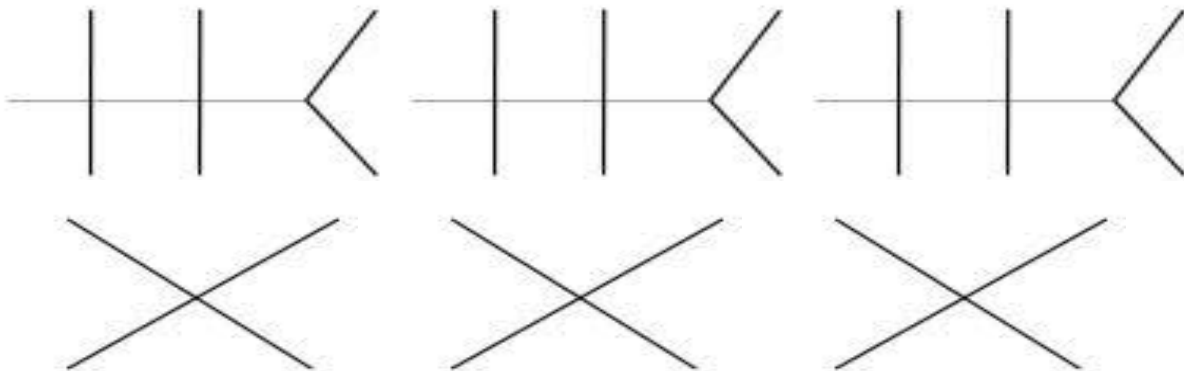
