Flint Masters of Social Work Program (2 or 3 year program options)

Students who have completed or will be completing a Bachelor’s degree may be considering going further in their education and completing a Masters Degree. Michigan State University has a Masters of Social Work degree program offered in Flint, with classes held on Mott campus. The University Center partners (Cleary, Davenport, Ferris, Rochester, and UMFlint) offer many Bachelor degree programs that would qualify.

The Flint Masters of Social Work program has a two year (full time) or three year (part time) option. All classes are held 6:00pm to 8:50pm with students coming 1-3 evenings a week for the full time and 1-2 evenings for the part time option. The program provides courses required for the Clinical Practice concentration (a focused concentration in providing social work assistance to individuals, families or groups) at the Flint location. The application period is August to January each year and those admitted would begin in the fall semester.
